Hultquist started his softball career in 1975 and played through 1988.

He played for several top level teams before joining the storied T's 13 club in 1984. He immediately moved to shortstop for T's, where his speed and quickness earned him a legendary reputation.

Hultquist played in 12 states and four national tournaments with T's.

“The games were always so competitive at the level we played,” Hultquist said, “that you had to develop a level of confidence. I grew to really enjoy being the guy to come up to the plate with two outs and the game on the line.”



“Steve was about half the size of most of the guys we played against,” said Terry Peterson team manager and sponsor for T's 13, “but had such talent for the game.

“He was our team's first career.600 hitter. He almost always hit leadoff for us. And for a little guy, he had some real pop. He could handle the bat as good as any player I have ever seen.

“He had great quickness and anticipation defensively. He was amazingly quick at getting rid of the ball. In his time, he was the best shortstop in the area. Nobody was even close.”
