Metro Omaha Softball 2009 Men's Slow Pitch City Tournament Tournament Rules

This is an ASA sanctioned tournament and the 2009 ASA rulebook will be followed.

Ball – ANY 12-inch 44.COR SOFTBALL white/optic yellow cover with a MAXIMUM compression of .400, ANY color stitching. UMPIRES MUST BE ABLE TO READ THE “CORE” DESIGNATION ON THE BALL OR IT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE PUT INTO PLAY. Teams provide softballs. Metro Omaha Softball will provide game balls for the semifinals and finals.

Runs Ahead Rule – 15 after 3 innings, 12 after 4 innings, 10 after 5 innings.

International Tiebreaker – At the conclusion of the time limit or after 7 innings.

Be ready – Your team should be ready to play 15 minutes prior to your scheduled start time.

Time Limit – One (1) hour. If ANY time remains on the clock a new inning will be played. Ninety (90) minute time limit on the championship game.

Roster – Your 2009 Metro Omaha Softball league roster as of July 1 must be used for this tournament. It is “frozen” at the time you submit your tournament entry form. No players can be added after July 1.

Protest – IF your team wishes to initiate a protest regarding the misapplication of a playing rule, then it must be made immediately. Contact the tournament administrator and ask for a ruling. The game will continue after a decision is made. Otherwise, all game officials' decisions are final.

Home Run Rule

- Class C – Three (3) over-the-fence home runs per team per game
- Class D – Two (2) over-the-fence home runs per team per game
- Class E – One (1) over-the-fence home run per team per game

“Casual Profanity Rule” – Will be in force throughout the tournament (an out may be assessed against a team for abusive language or behavior.)

Ejection-Suspension – If a player or coach is ejected by a game official—either for behavior or an illegal bat—the player or coach CANNOT PLAY OR COACH IN THE TEAM'S NEXT GAME.

Metro Omaha Softball 2008 Adult Slow Pitch Co-Ed City Tournament Tournament Rules

This is an ASA sanctioned tournament and the 2009 ASA rules pertaining to Co-Ed Softball (as published in the 2009 Rule Book) will be followed.

Ball – *ANY 11-inch and 12-inch 44.COR SOFTBALL* white/optic yellow cover, red/blue stitching. UMPIRES MUST BE ABLE TO READ THE “CORE” DESIGNATION ON THE BALL OR IT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE PUT INTO PLAY. Teams provide softballs. Metro Omaha Softball will provide game balls for the semifinals and finals.

Runs Ahead Rule – 15 after 3 innings, 12 after 4 innings, 10 after 5 innings.

International Tiebreaker – At the conclusion of the time limit or after 7 innings.

Be ready – Your team should be ready to play 15 minutes prior to your scheduled start time.

Time Limit – One (1) hour. If ANY time remains on the clock a new inning will be played. Ninety (90) minute time limit on the championship game.

Home Run Rule

- Class D – One (1) over-the-fence home run per team per game
- Class E – NO over-the-fence home runs

“Casual Profanity Rule” – Will be in force throughout the tournament (an out may be assessed against a team for abusive language or behavior.)

Ejection-Suspension – If a player or coach is ejected by a game official—either for behavior or an illegal bat—the player or coach CANNOT PLAY OR COACH IN THE TEAM'S NEXT GAME.
