- MAIL-IN REGISTRATION – To register your team for 2010, just complete the registration form and mail it back to us. If you have questions, contact us at any time.
- ON THE WEBSITE – You can also access all the registration materials at metroomahasoftball.com. The “registration” page has everything you'll need.
- Forfeit Fees – MUST be received when you pay your league registration fee. We prefer that your forfeit fee be paid with a separate check—which will be kept at the MOS office. It will not be deposited. However, if you MUST include the forfeit fee on one check, that will be acceptable. **All forfeit fee checks will be discarded at the end of the year unless you inform us otherwise.**
- A 2010 “Player Roster and Waiver and Indemnification Form” MUST BE completed and on file at the Metro Omaha Softball office. You can also complete this item and mail it to us. HOWEVER, ABSOLUTELY NO TEAM SCHEDULES WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THE WAIVER/ROSTER FORM AND FORFEIT FEE ARE BOTH ON FILE AT THE OFFICE. WE WILL NOT MAIL TEAM SCHEDULES. WHAT THIS MEANS IS THAT YOU WILL NEED TO MAKE AT LEAST ONE TRIP TO THE OFFICE.
- Credit Card payment – Metro Omaha Softball WILL accept credit card payments, but only at the office.
- Awards – The players on each League Championship and runner-up team will receive awards from Mizuno.

2010 Metro Omaha Softball Girls' Fast Pitch League

Monday Night

10U and 12U Division I and Division II – Division I is designed generally for those teams with players who have advanced skills and are committed to playing a “competitive” schedule. Division II is for teams with coaches and players who are new to the sport and also prefer to play in a less competitive environment.

Tuesday Night

High School Division I. Pitch from 43 feet. This league is designed generally for those teams with players who were members of their high school varsity teams. Or they may have been “swing” players between the junior varsity and varsity teams. **There is no age restriction per se.** In terms of high school grade level, the league is designed for juniors and seniors. The overall purpose of the league, though, is to provide a strong, competitive venue for players in the older (16-18) high school age groups.

Possible limit: 24 teams.

Wednesday night

High School Division II. Pitch from 43 feet. This league is designed generally for those teams with players who were members of their high school JUNIOR VARSITY teams or were “swing players.” **There is no age restriction per se.** In terms of high school grade level, the league is designed for freshmen and sophomores. The purpose of the league is to provide a strong, competitive venue for players in the younger (14-15) high school age groups.

Possible limit: 21 teams.

Thursday night – 14U

Pitch from 40 feet. The league is generally designed for teams that are comprised mostly of 7th and 8th grade players OR “young” 14U players. Division I is designed generally for those teams with players who have advanced skills and are committed to playing a “competitive” schedule. Division II is for teams with coaches and players who are new to the sport and also prefer to play in a less competitive environment.
